Tokyo University of Foreign Studies

Tokyo University of Foreign Studies (TUFS) is the oldest academic institution devoted to international studies in Japan. It began as Institute for Research of Foreign Documents set up in 1857. It was subsequently established as an independent educational and research institution with the name Tokyo School of Foreign Languages in 1873 and gained independence in 1899. In 1949, it was formed as a new-system university as the Tokyo University of Foreign Studies.

TUFS is a specialized institution only in foreign language, international affairs and foreign studies. It is ranked #101-150 in QS World University Rankings by Subject 2025. Some of the languages taught at TUFS are rarely taught in Japan or anywhere else in the world. anguage departments cover the following languages: Arabic, Bengali, Burmese, Cambodian, Chinese, Czech, English, German, French, Hindi, Indonesian, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Laotian, Malaysian, Mongolian, Persian, Polish, Portuguese, Russian, Spanish, Tagalog, Thai, Turkish, Urdu, Vietnamese.





Tokyo National Museum

The Tokyo National Museum collects, houses, and displays a comprehensive collection of art works and antiquities from Japan as well as other Asian countries. The museum also conducts research and investigations concerning its collection of books, rubbings, and photographs, related to fine art, and makes these items available to scholars.

The Independent Administrative Institution National Museum and the Independent Administrative Institution Research Institute of Cultural Properties were merged as of April 1, 2007 to create the Independent Administrative Institution National Institute for Cultural Property. National Institutes for Cultural Heritage was established in order to carry out preservation and utilization of cultural properties more efficiently and effectively.





Ueno Zoological Gardens

Ueno Zoological Gardens, established in 1882, is the Japan's oldest and most visited zoo. The zoo houses 3,000 animals of about 300 species. In addition to animals unique to Japan, the zoo is also home to rare animals such as giant pandas and okapi, known as the "forest giraffe", brought from the jungles of Central Africa and Zaire. Visitors can learn how they are cared for and gain insight into the zoo's unique history as the first established in Japan. Dedicated to wildlife conservation and increasing public awareness, it cooperates with various domestic and international agencies in breeding endangered animals.





Tokyo Disneyland

Tokyo Disneyland was the first Disney Park to be built outside the United States and it opened on April 15, 1983. The park has seven themed areas: the World Bazaar, Adventureland, Westernland, Fantasyland, Tomorrowland, Critter Country and Toontown. Many of these areas mirror those in the original Disneyland as they are based on American Disney films and fantasies. In 2023, Tokyo Disneyland hosted 15.1 million visitors, making it the fourth-most visited theme park in the world and the second-most visited theme park in Asia.






Asakusa Temple (Senso-ji)

Asakusa Temple is an ancient Buddhist temple in Asakusa, Tokyo, Japan. It is Tokyo's oldest-established temple, and one of its most significant. The temple was destroyed during a 10 March 1945 firebombing air raid on Tokyo during World War II. The main hall was rebuilt in the 1950s. Formerly associated with the Tendai sect of Buddhism, the temple became independent after the war.

Catering to the visiting crowds, the surrounding area has many traditional shops and eating places that feature traditional dishes. Nakamise-Dori, the street leading from the Thunder Gate to the temple itself, is lined with small shops selling souvenirs ranging from fans, ukiyo-e (woodblock prints), kimono and other robes, Buddhist scrolls, traditional sweets, to Godzilla toys, t-shirts and mobile phone straps.





Odaiba

The man-made island of Odaiba is a popular destination for Tokyo locals and international tourists alike, known for its shopping malls, dining, futuristic attractions, and museums, all easily accessible by foot.

At the center of Odaiba is the sprawling Aqua City Odaiba shopping mall complex. The boutique building runs for 300 meters along the waterside and offers everything from high-end fashion to quirky bargain buys. A futuristic multiplex cinema is the hub of entertainment in the area, which also features a Legoland Discovery Center and a virtual Sega theme park, Joypolis.
